7.	LIGHTING UP		Light up immediately adjacent to line leeward break. Second run to be not more than 3m from the leeward edge of the fire. Further runs to be done in as straight a line as possible eg. 20m wide. In paddocks where there are no trees the fire should be lit around the perimeter so that it draws towards the center of the paddock.	As per stage 1	As per Stage 1
8.	REGULAR PATROLS	Continuous patrols until fire extinguished	FIRE NOT TO BE LEFT UNTIL FULLY EXTINGUISHED. Regular patrols on the following day with emphasis on the time between 8.00am and 3.00pm	As per Stage 1	As per Stage 1
