I, further agree to indemnify and to keep indemnified and to hold harmless the Council, its servants and each of them from, and against all actions, costs, claims, charges, expenses and damages, whatsoever, which may be brought or made or claimed against them arising out of or in relation to our entry to the Mount Shadwell Quarry.

I further agree that I will re-imburse Council for any costs incurred due to damage to plant, equipment and or any part of the facility.

Conditions of Entry – Mount Shadwell Quarry

- 1. Whilst in the quarry, the entrant shall abide by all directions given by the Quarry Manager, or his representative
- 2. The entrant will confine his activities to the areas designated by the Quarry Manager or his representative.
- 3. The entrant shall not approach within 40 metres of any working plant, vehicles, or equipment, and shall not approach within 10 metres of any non-working plant, vehicles, equipment or building.
- 4. The entrant shall not approach within 3 metres of the top, or toe of any batter or face which is steeper than 1.5 horizontally to 1 vertically.
- 5. The entrant shall, at all times whilst the quarry is operating, remain clear of all access tracks being used for quarry operations, and shall not in any way restrict the operations of the quarry.
- 6. The entrant shall be aware that there is a risk of loose material moving underfoot, and shall wear appropriate footwear and clothing to minimise the risk of injury due to falls.
- 7. Children shall be properly supervised by an adult at all times, whilst at the quarry, and they shall comply with the above conditions, to the satisfaction of the Quarry Supervisor.
