## Do's & don'ts

- Do place your bins on the nature strip with the wheels and handles facing your property.
- Do put your bins out the night before collection.
- Do space your bins at least one metre apart.
- Do not place heavy objects on the lid of your bin.
- Do not overfill your bin - the lid must shut.
- Do not place recycling in your bin inside plastic bags.

This calendar specifies the week in which either FOGO or Recycling is collected. The day your bins are emptied are specified below:

- Monday – Port Fairy
- Tuesday – Illowa, Tower Hill, Killarney, Crossley, Port Fairy Outer, Rosebrook, Toolong, Yambuk, Orford, Macarthur, Hawkesdale, Kirkstall
- Wednesday – Koroit, Southern Cross, Woolsthorpe, Winslow, Mailors Flat, Grassmere, Purnim
- Thursday – Mortlake, Ellerslie, Hexham, Caramut, Chatsworth, Woorndoo, Cudgee, Panmure, Garvoc, Laang, Framlingham, Wangoom
- Friday – Naringal, Ayrford, Nirranda East, Nirranda South, Peterborough, Nirranda, Nullawarre, Mepunga East, Mepunga West.
