STATE GOVERNMENT

- 50% by 2030 Victorian Renewable Energy Target (VRET)
- Renewable Energy Road Maps
- ZERO by 2050 Greenhouse Gas Emissions
- Onshore Gas moratorium lifted
- Energy affordability & efficiency programs

TRANSITION to a NEW ENERGY SYSTEM in MOYNE

VICTORIAN COMMUNITY ACCEPTANCE

- 78% support the 2050 zero emissions target
 - 84% support the State's renewable energy targets
 - 75% would support wind turbines in their area providing local renewable energy
 - 9 in 10 would support solar panels in their area providing local renewable energy
- (Sustainability Victoria 2017)

ENERGY MARKETS

- Renewables cheapest form of new build electricity generation (CSIRO 2020)
- Aging coal generation fleet, imminent retirements
- Emerging gas supplies
