How well do you know what goes in your bin?

Q. What does FOGO stand for?

A. Food Organics Garden Organics

Q. What are the four colours of the kerbside bins and what goes in?

A. Yellow - Recycling
Green - FOGO
Purple - Glass ONLY
Red - Landfill

Q. What do the triangle symbols on plastic material / items mean?

A. The number in the triangle identifies what kind of plastic the item is made from, NOT whether it is recyclable.

Q. What are the recycling symbol numbers on plastics that do go in your yellow recycling bin?

A. 1, 2 and 5 - For example; milk, soft drink, water, sauce and cleaning product bottles.

Q. When you put glass jars, bottles, mirrors and windows in your purple Glass ONLY bin, what don't you include?

A. No lids and no frames.

Q. Can items for your red Landfill bin go in a bag and then into your bin?

A. Yes - place all items for this bin in a bag or container to reduce the chance of waste blowing out during collection.

Q. Can items for your yellow Recycling bin and purple Glass ONLY bin go in a bag?

A. No - place all items in the bin loose, plastic bags cause major problems for recycling machinery.

Q. Where do soft scrunchable plastics go?

A. Soft plastics, such as; shopping bags, chip packets and bubble wrap can all be recycled (just not in your kerbside bins). Check the **RedCycle** website for a complete list of what is and isn't accepted in the RedCycle bins at participating Coles and Woolworth stores www.redcycle.net.au

Q. What happens to your waste materials if they are put in the wrong bin?

A. They are not recycled, cannot be separated from recyclable materials and can cause the whole truck load to be sent to landfill.

Q. If you're not sure what to do with an item or material - which bin should you use?

A. The red Landfill bin, so that the other bins are not contaminated and can be recycled.
