

4 BINS - put the right things in!



What can I put in the green FOGO bin?

- Leftover food, vegetable peels, dairy products
- Green compostable bag liners filled with contents
- Grass clippings, flowers, weeds, leaves
- Small branches and twigs
- Dog droppings, meat, fish, prawn shells
- Coffee grounds, tea bags
- Egg shells, hair, feathers
- Soiled tissues, paper towels, food wrap



What can I put in the yellow recycling bin?

Plastics with recycle triangle symbol numbered 1, 2 or 5

- Milk bottles, juice and cream containers
- Food containers - icecream, yoghurt and Takeaway containers
- Water, sauce, cordial and cleaning product bottles

Paper and cardboard

- Pizza boxes (empty)
- Unsoiled fish & chip wrap
- Newspapers and magazines
- Cardboard, cereal/food boxes
- Wrapping paper, cards
- Envelopes and gift boxes

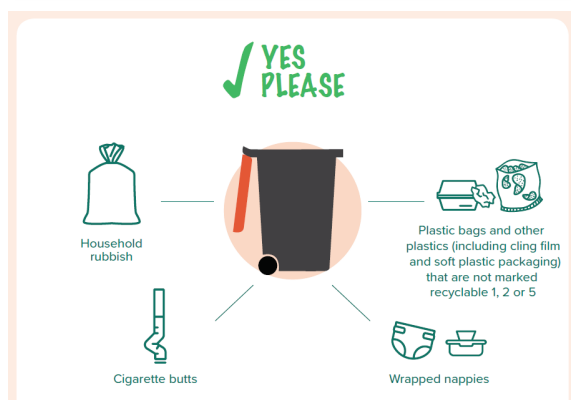
Aluminium and steel

- All empty steel cans
- Aluminium soft drink cans
- Clean aluminium foil/pie trays
- Empty aerosol cans



What can I put in the purple glass only bin?

- Bottles (no lids)
- Jars (no lids)
- Window glass and mirrors (no frames)
- Pyrex
- Glassware



What can I put in red the landfill bin?

- **Items that are not listed above**
- Plastics with the recycle triangle numbered 3, 4, 6 or 7.
- Cartons, Long-life Tetra Pak
- Plastic bags
- Balloons
- Plastic wrap
- Nappies, Wipes (wrapped)
- Tableware, ceramics
- Polystyrene
